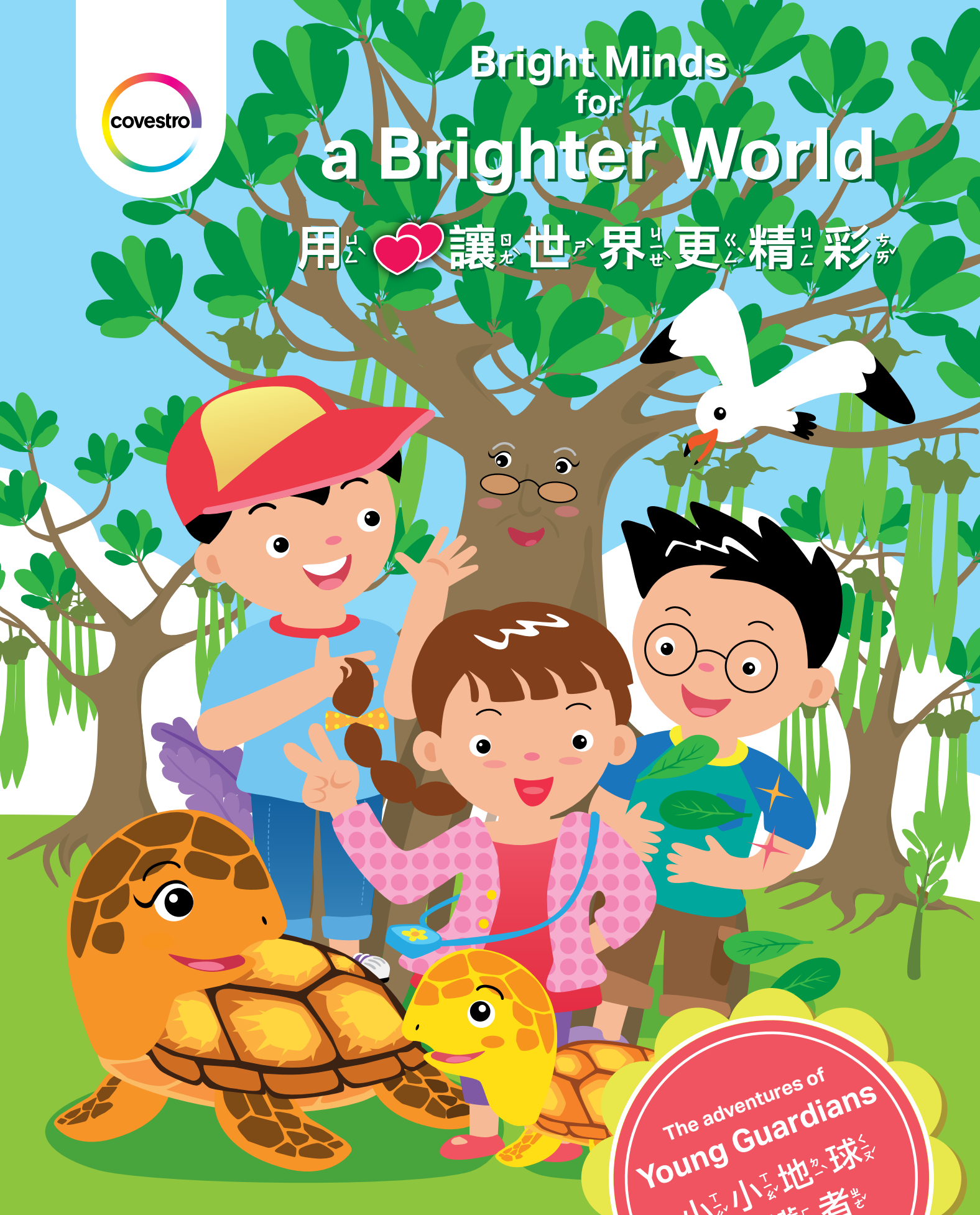

Oh, on my way here, I also saw Aunt Dolphin. She cannot swim well. Something is wrapped around her fin and tail. Please help her, too.



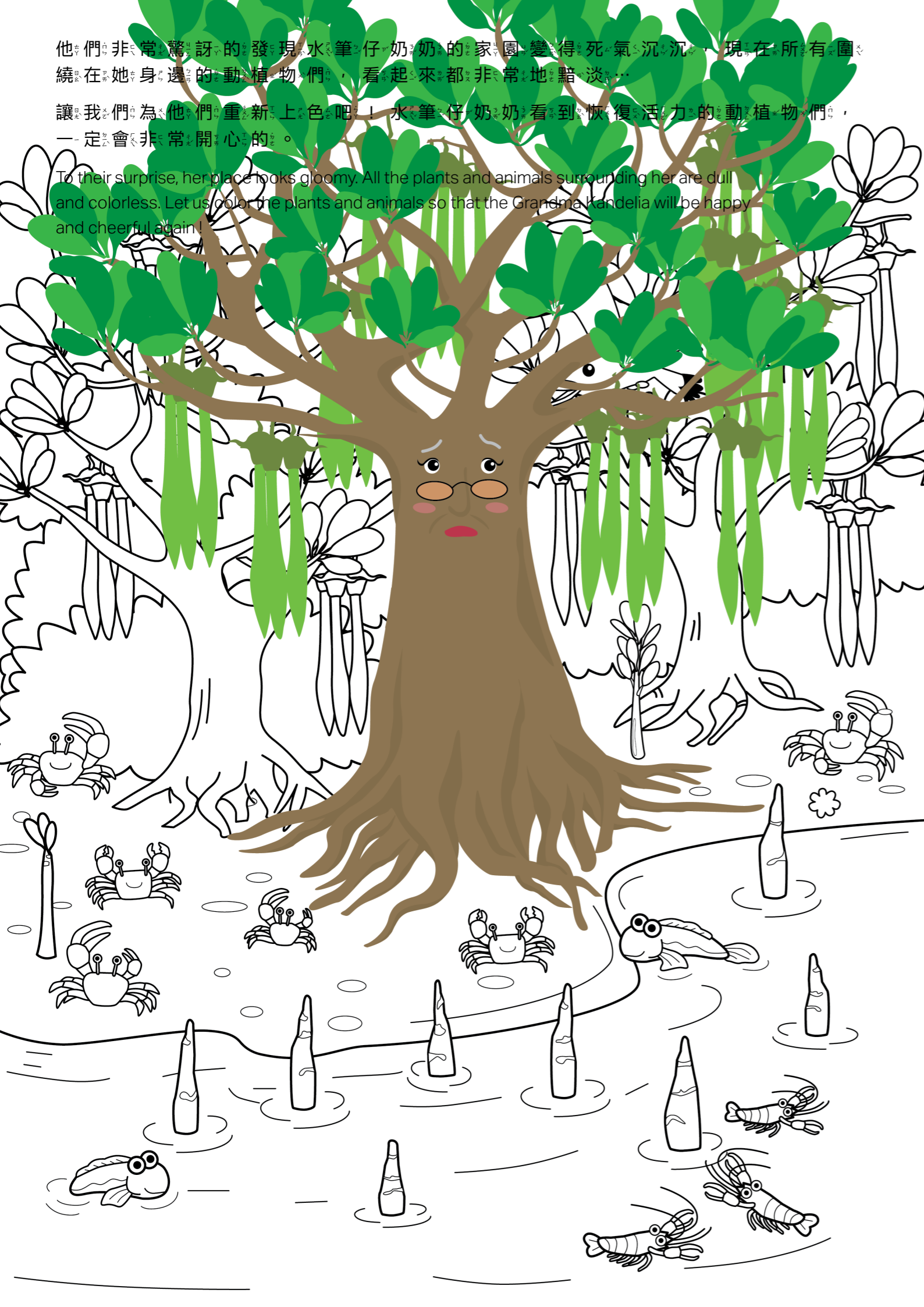
小小地球守護者們即刻出發，奔向一棵紅樹林老樹——水筆仔奶奶，希望她能為他們指引方向。

幫助海豚阿姨之後，他們連忙啟程去協助海龜媽媽。

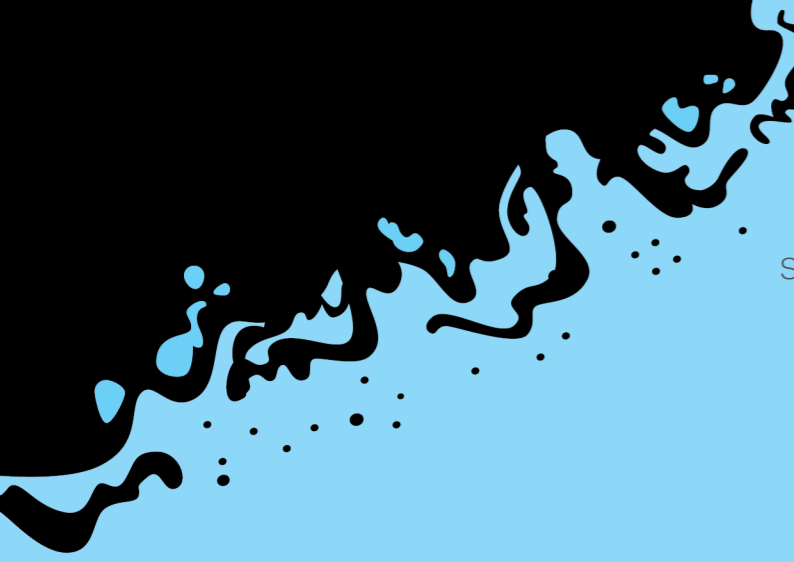
After helping Aunt Dolphin, the Young Guardians hurry to help the young sea turtle's mom.

Now, it is time for the Young Guardians to take care of the patch of garbage.

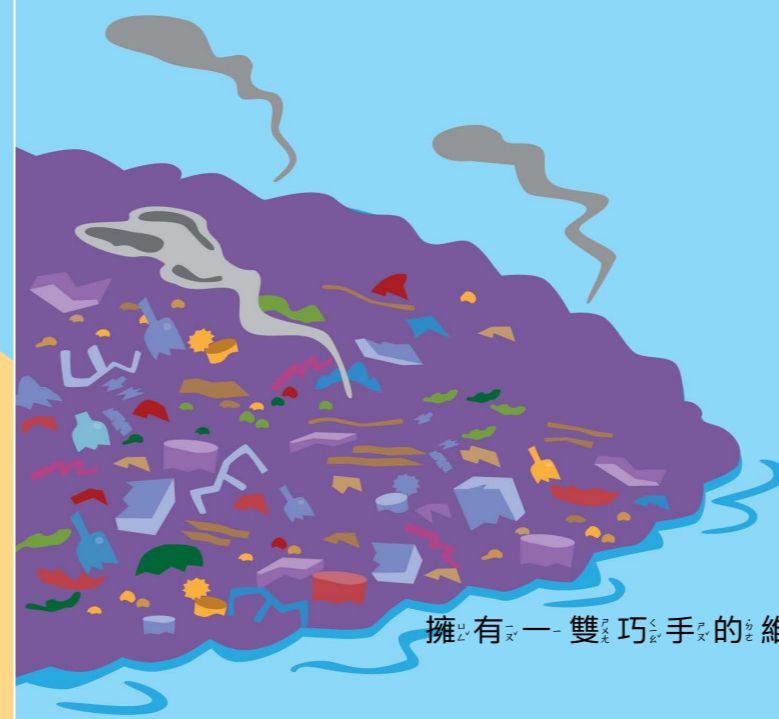


擁有一雙巧手的維克用海藻做了一張堅固的大網子。

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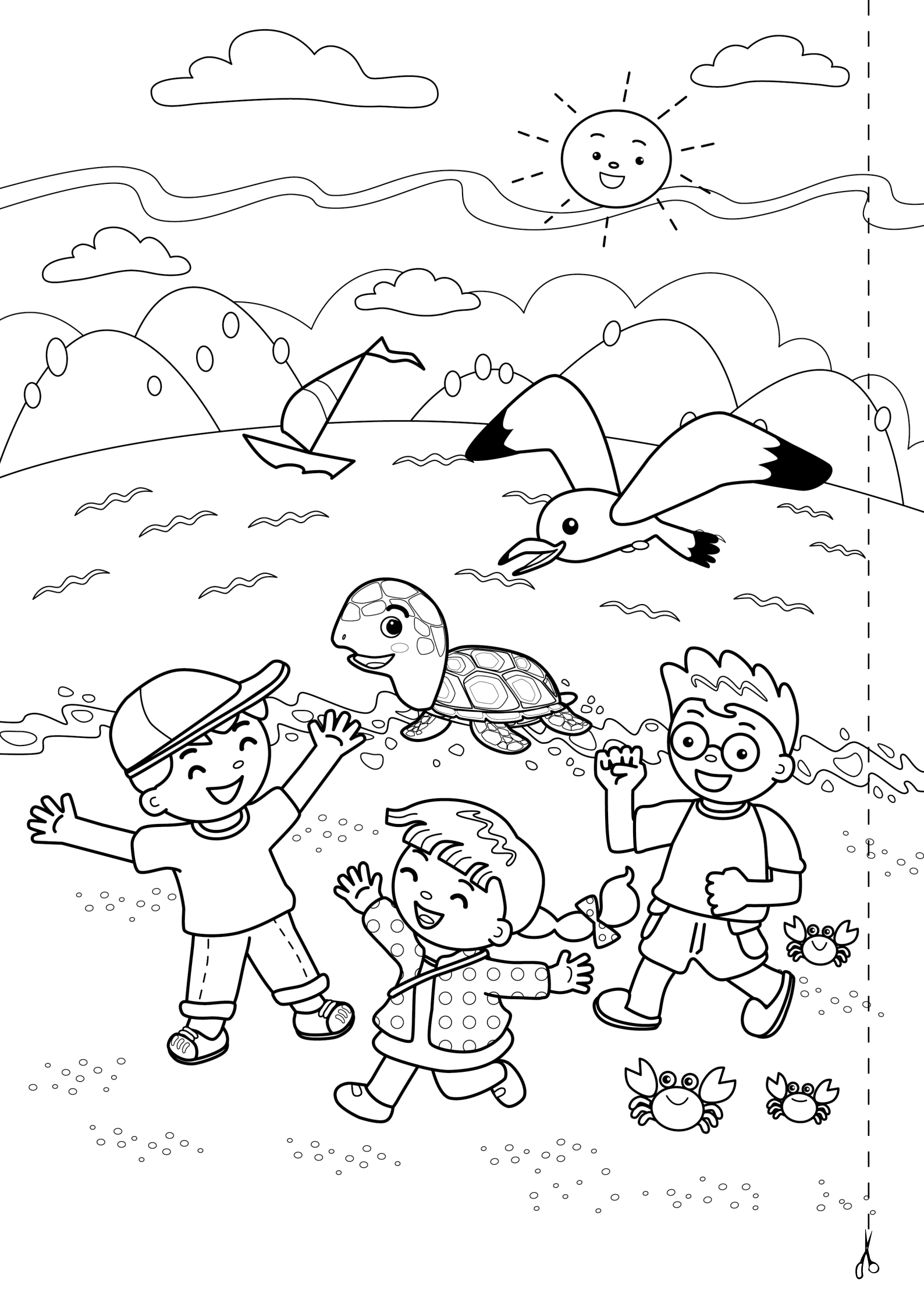
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故事繪本推廣夥伴：

臺灣沿海近10多年來海漂垃圾漸趨嚴重，國家公園也面臨同樣的問題，並以塑膠為最大宗。而塑膠製品需要400年才能自然分解，除了嚴重危害海底珊瑚礁生態之外，甚至造成海洋生物誤食致死；其分解的塑膠微粒進入生態系，透過食物鏈進入人體，也進入陸域水系、地下水，影響深遠。在此藉由繪本呼籲所有的家長，為保育我們重要的國家公園資源，讓我們一起當國家公園的不塑之客。
